FAA Part 139 Live Fire Refresher

Description

One day/ 8 hours course with hydrocarbon, handline operations, 3- dimensional firefighting and interior firefighting. The course can be combined with one half day vehicle and turret firefighting refresher. Course price includes all accommodation-PPE/ SCBA supply and ground transportation hotel-training center. Optional 4-hour second day of training for vehicle and turret operations.
